Council Highlights from August 28, 2023

- Thirteen Kolocreeka lots have been approved for sale at a discount, watch for advertising!
- A six month update to Council's Strategic Plan Implementation was presented to Council.
- First reading of the new Community Standards Bylaw with property maintenance and noise changes being brought back to the September 25, 2023 Regular Council Meeting.
- The Doctor Retention & Recruitment Policy was rescinded and will be replaced with the newly approved Physician and Health Care Professional Committee Bylaw. This will expand the mandate to include the retention and recruitment of Physicians, Veterinarians, Nurses, Dentists, Pharmasists, Physiotherapists and other health care professionals in the region.
- Council approved one Town owned sandstone rock to be donated to the

Smoky Lake Golf Course. The rock will be used to create a memorial to Ron Sorokan.

- The Town's annual contribution of \$5,000 to the Smoky Lake Regional Heritage Board was approved.
- Council approved working with Alberta Counsel for the purpose of applying for the Affordable Housing Partnership Program. This is intended to allow for the construction of an affordable tiny homes community within Smoky Lake.
- Council directed Administration to draft a letter of support for CASA to help them with applications for funding development of a playground at the new H.A. Kostash School site.

## **Drive Happiness**

After a lifetime of hard work, seniors want to live healthy, safe, and independent lives. Many seniors want to stay in the communities that support them for as long as possible. In our community, a significant challenge we face is a lack of seniors' transportation. To help solve this gap, the Smoky Lake Region developed a partnership with Drive Happiness; a non-profit organisation that operates a volunteer-based driver program. The Minister of Seniors, Kamal Khera, recently announced that under the scaling-up for Senior's stream of the Age Well at Home initiative, Drive Happiness will receive \$556,634 for their Rural Access to Transportation Expansion. The Drive Happiness project will expand volunteer-assisted transportation for seniors and increase access to in-home supports in rural settings in Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Cyber-Seniors is a non-profit organisation that specialized in teaching tech to seniors, by leveraging Youth Volunteers. The idea for Cyber-Seniors came from a high school project that was launched by the founders of Cyber-Seniors, Macaulee and Kascha Cassaday in 2009, when they were 16 and 18 respectively.
