- Council approved a 25 year lease agreement with Algonquin Shooting Sports Association for the lands located at SW-27-59-17-W4.
- Council approved the installation of sidewalks on 50 St. to the new school once an agreement has been made with Aspen View Public School Division.
- Council has directed Administration to pursue volunteer firefighter incentives including municipal property tax reductions and local business partnerships. Stay tuned for more.
- The annual budget for the Physicians and Health Care Professionals Committee was adopted. The Town of Smoky Lake's portion for this regional committee is \$6,240.00.
- Council has asked Administration to draft a Water Restriction Bylaw in response to drought concerns.
- Due to drought concerns, Council supported a motion made at the Regional Fire Meeting to establish a Wildfire Rapid Response Program to provide additional firefighter resources

during wild fire season.

- Town of Smoky Lake was a successful applicant for the 2023-24 Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) Grant for the Regional Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Infrastructure Study on 46 St.
- Council has approved the sale of four more Kolocreeka lots:

To have your tax return completed at no charge, your single income must be below \$35,000.00. If you have a dual income, it must be below \$45,000.00. 
