STREET CLOSURE POLICY

Legislative Reference: Municipal Government Act & Alberta Highway Safety Act

1. PURPOSE

1.1 To provide Public Works and Administration guidelines for providing consistent and efficient methods of processing and issuing street closure permits as well as ensuring safety of motorists and pedestrians.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 In this policy:
 - a) "Street Closure" shall mean the temporary closure of a street to all but specifically authorized motor vehicles for the protection of pedestrians.

3. POLICY STATEMENT

- 3.1 An association or organization that wishes to have a street or multiple streets closed for a special event will complete an "Application for Street Closure Permit". This application form is contained in "Schedule A" of this policy.
- 3.2 Applications for street closure shall be received at the Town Office at least one (1) month in advance of the proposed street closure date.
- 3.3 Street Closure Permits will be issued at the discretion of Town Council.
- 3.4 The following streets and highways shall not be considered in an application for street closure without prior approval from Alberta Transportation.
 - a) 50th Street (Highway 855)
- 3.5 A Street Closure Permit may be cancelled if the applicant is found to have made false or misleading statements on the application form.
- 3.6 There shall be no fee payment required for an Application for a Street Closure Permit.

- 3.7 Town of Smoky Lake Public Works shall provide set-up and removal of barricades and other applicable traffic control signage or devices for the street closure during regular business hours. If street closure is scheduled for an evening or weekend, traffic control devices shall be delivered to the location by Public Works during business hours and applicant will be responsible for setup and removal of the traffic devices from the roadway.
- 3.8 Town of Smoky Lake shall notify applicable Emergency Services of the street closure (Fire Department, RCMP, and EMS).
- 3.9 Operations of Town of Smoky Public Works, and utility or road construction shall be exempt from this policy.
- 3.10 The applicant shall be responsible for ensuring personnel are actively monitoring barricades and other traffic control devices for the duration of the scheduled street closure if the street closure is on any of the following roads:
 - a) 55 Avenue
 - b) West Railway Drive
 - c) 44 Avenue
 - d) East Railway Drive

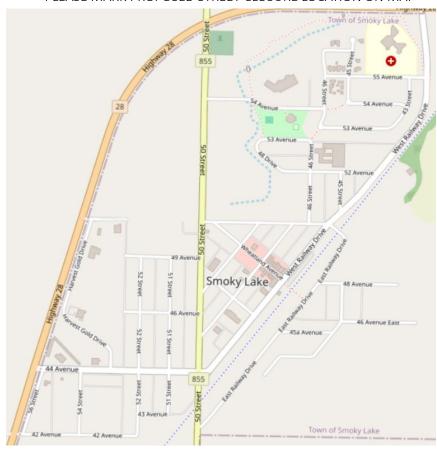
